



POLICY ON TUITION, FEES AND REFUNDS

1. Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine (MSUCOM) students must follow policies, procedures and regulations with regard to tuition, fees and refunds, as determined by Michigan State University (MSU) for Graduate-Professional students.
 - a. General information, policies, procedures and regulations are available to students in the online MSU Academic Programs Catalog on the MSU Office of the Registrar website <https://reg.msu.edu/AcademicPrograms/Text.aspx?Section=112>
 - b. Students are assessed charges for tuition and fees on a semester basis.
 - c. Refund of tuition and fees is determined as followed:
 - i. For courses dropped, or student withdrawals, through the first $\frac{1}{4}$ of the semester of instruction (measured in weekdays, not class days), 100% of the semester course fees and tuition will be refunded.
 - ii. For courses dropped, or student withdrawals, after the first $\frac{1}{4}$ of the semester of instruction, and through the end of the semester, no refund will be made.
