- History of TMD 1950-2017
- Basic orthopedics of joint function and dysfunction
  - TMD as a joint injury
  - Stages of TMJ injuries
  - Four levels of pathology
  - Alteration of function of the muscles of mastication
  - Etiologies of joint injuries of the TMJ
    - Overuse syndromes
    - The only emergency condition of a TMJ
    - Indication for intervention
      - Presence of joint pathology
      - Episodes of locking
      - Overuse syndromes
      - Pain
- When consideration for treatment may be indicated
  - Patient requesting orthodontic treatment
  - Patient requires full mouth or major dental reconstruction
  - Pain and dysfunction
- Principles of Treatment
  - Non-surgical
    - Sprain
    - Severe sprain
    - Internal joint derangement
    - Joint dysfunction
  - Surgical
    - Loss of cortical bone on condylar head
