

MSUCOM Students - Application Process for McLaren Macomb

Applications for electives and auditions for 2018 will open on February 1, 2018. Applications will be accepted at that time and rotations will be scheduled for April 1st and after. No applications will be accepted before this time. If applications are submitted before this date they will be deleted and will need to be resubmitted on or after February 1st. Please see below for the scheduling and application process.

All rotations will need final approval from the school no less than 60 days prior to the start date of the rotation. This rule will be enforced due to the overwhelming amount of rotation requests expected. Rotations will automatically be cancelled if all approval paperwork is not received. A letter from your school approving the rotation with exact dates, proof of malpractice and proof of up to date immunizations must be received.

ALL rotations are scheduled on a first come first serve basis (from when the completed application is received through email). Students will need to complete the on-line application and send to me along with their CV and COMLEX/USMLE scores to schedule a rotation. The on-line application can be found at <https://sites.google.com/mclarenmeded.org/macombgme/student-rotations>. **One application needs to be completed for each separate rotation. Exact dates and exact rotation must be completed on the application.** In addition, MSUCOM students need to apply through the kobiljak application process for final approval.

Keep in mind that rotations will NOT be scheduled without receiving the application, COMLEX/USMLE scores and CV at the same time. Due to an overwhelming number of emails, if all 3 are not received at the same time the email will be deleted and it will need to be resubmitted. Once the completed application is received, and the rotation is available, the student will be placed on my schedule and sent a confirmation email. *If a particular rotation is full students are welcome to check back for cancellations as a wait list is not kept.*

All rotations are scheduled for 4 weeks. The Urology Program is strongly recommending 4 week rotations but will accept a two week rotation if you absolutely have to. All McLaren Macomb programs give priority to those candidates that have passed exams on the first attempt during the selection process. Orthopedics and General Surgery require a minimum COMLEX score of 500 to rotate here. The Emergency Medicine and Internal Medicine programs are only participating in the National Residency Matching Program. The Urology program will only be participating in the AUA Urology Residency Match. Otolaryngology will NOT be accepting any residents for 2019.

The only program that will be accepting J-1 visa's at this time is Internal Medicine. As of now you must be a US citizen or have a Permanent Resident/Green card to rotate with all of our other programs.

Student housing is also scheduled on a first come first serve basis. The housing fee is \$100 per week. The full 4 weeks is payable on your first day at orientation. **If you do not check housing on your application you will not be considered for it.** Please only check housing if you are absolutely sure you will be staying there.
