

If you are considering Summer 2016 enrollment and would like to apply for financial aid, you must notify the Office of Financial Aid before March 1, 2016.

For most financial aid programs, you must be enrolled at least half-time. It is important that you only enroll in courses that you plan to complete or you may be subject to a bill at a later date for dropping summer courses.

To be considered for 2016 summer aid, you need to file the 2015-16 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and have it released to MSU – school code 002290.

If you have already filed the 2015-16 FAFSA for another school, you can add MSU as a school to receive the data. If you have not already filed, you can do so at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).

Note: the deadline to file the 2015-16 FAFSA is 6/30/16. However, you are urged to take IMMEDIATE action in order that the Office of Financial Aid can process your application prior to the summer tuition bill available on 4/16/16 and due on 5/6/16.
