Congratulations and welcome to the MSU College of Osteopathic Medicine. Please order the items below before you attend the MSUCOM in-person Orientation. Click: Orientation – Class of 2024. For U.S. students, money will be in your Summer Financial Aid (June 2020) to cover up to \$540 worth of items. You will pay upfront with a credit card **by July 17, 2020**, or you can order at any time before that date. For those students receiving a scholarship through the U.S. Armed Forces, you will also pay for your orientation items and the Office of Enrollment Services and Student Records will help you with paperwork so that your branch can reimburse you.

Additionally, you will receive \$1,200 in your Summer Financial Aid to help cover costs of the medical equipment for Semester 2. The Course Director will have a detailed list equipment, cost and vendors on your class website. Equipment does not need to be ordered until late July.

***Consultation White Coat (short) - unisex**

Description: Consultation coat worn for pre-clerkship and clerkship years, all official college events and preceptor rotations. Embroidered with MSUCOM logo.

How to Measure: Measure around largest area of your chest (under your armpits). A larger coat will fit better than a smaller one, so if you measure at 43", order a 44.

Sizes: 30 = 0, 32 = 2, 34 = 4, 36 = 6, 38 = 8, 40 = 10, 42 = 12, 44 = 14, 46 = 16, 48 = 18, 50 = 20, 52 = 22, 54 = 24, 56 = 28, 58 = 30

Cost: \$0 No Charge - Gift from the College

***Class of 2024 Dues**

Description: Dues pay for food at class meetings (years 1 and 2), Fee Follies (2nd year), graduation banquet (4th year), yearbook (4th year), administrative fees and social events throughout pre-clerkship years one and two.

Cost: \$350

***Student Osteopathic Medical Association (SOMA) Membership**

Description: The osteopathic organization that all MSUCOM students are required to become members. SOMA organizes national speakers, D.O. the Monster Dash 5K run/walk, D.O. Day on the Hill (Washington, DC), lunches featuring physicians for Specialty Spotlights, grants for traveling to local and national conventions.

Cost: \$135

***Nametag**

Description: Magnetic nametag worn for academics and college/organization events. Type your name to appear on your nametag (First name, middle initial, last name).

Cost: \$24

Scrubs Sets - unisex

Description: Great to wear during summer Anatomy course or osteopathic manipulative medicine (OMM) lab. Scrubs RUN LARGE

Sizes: XXS – Dark Jade Only, All other sizes Light Jade, XS, S, M, L, XL, XXL

Note: If you already have scrubs, you may use them.

Cost: \$32 per set (tops and pants and be mixed – we can adjust during orientation or you can email us when you order).
