

DUE PROCESS POLICY

Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine (MSUCOM; the College) affirms and adheres to all Michigan State University (MSU; the University) policies relating to due process. Specifically, those policies pertaining to employees, students, faculty and credentialed instructional staff. Relevant policies are included here.

Faculty Grievance Procedure

- This MSU Faculty Grievance policy is intended to provide a fair, internal process for resolving employment-related disputes that arise between faculty or academic staff members and administrators.
- 2. The formal procedures described in this Policy are intended to be used only when matters cannot be resolved informally.
- 3. A faculty or academic staff member who feels aggrieved should first seek an informal resolution at the unit, department, or college level before filing a formal grievance under this policy.
- 4. The procedures contained in this policy are not intended to be used to challenge the desirability of unit or University policies.

Non-Tenured Faculty in Tenure System

- 1. Recommendations for actions affecting the appointment, reappointment or promotion of faculty members under the tenure system must be in accord with the provisions of the tenure system.

Non-Union Regular Support Staff Grievance Procedure

- Workplace differences may be worked out amicably between the employee and his/her supervisor,
 In the event that this is not possible, an employee may initiate a complaint alleging a violation,
 misinterpretation or a misapplication of existing written University policies concerning wages, hours
 and working conditions which he/she feels deserves further attention, and have a systematic and
 orderly method of presenting such a complaint, or a difference of opinion for review.
